



Flotilla to Victoria and the San Juan Islands

You are invited to participate in our June 15 – June 22, 2012 Victoria and San Juan Islands Flotilla. Our fleet of some ten boats will sail the same itinerary and gather for cookouts, dinners ashore, dinghy races and other activities. Experienced skippers and first-time crew are both welcome! Your flotilla leader will be on hand throughout for advice and guidance.

The city of Victoria boasts a spectacular harbor, and we will be tying up for two nights right at the famous Empress Hotel. We also visit tranquil, isolated Winter Cove on Saturna Island, one of the Canadian Gulf Islands.

For centuries the call of the San Juan Islands of northwest Washington State has lured adventurous mariners seeking a special place. The hundreds of San Juan Islands range from small rocky outcrops to large forest-clad mountainous masses. Wildlife abounds on the land and in the sea. You're just as likely to encounter tiny squirrels, deer and bald eagles as you are to see seals, sea lions and orca whales.

June 2012 ASA Flotilla

Join fellow sailors in cruising the beautiful San Juan Island and Gulf Islands Archipelagos. This cruise offers a variety of excellent cruising destinations to discover, including elegant resorts, small island towns and idyllic anchorages. Planned stops include the lively and historic city of Victoria (Vancouver Island), peaceful Winter Cove (Saturna Island), circa 1880's Roche Harbor (San Juan Island), elegant Rosario Resort (Orcas Island) and the spectacular, sandy beaches of Indian Cove (Shaw Island).

Agenda:

Friday, June 15 – Arrive 3:30pm. Attend 4:30pm skippers meeting, followed by an onboard systems checkout. Stay aboard your boat (gear and grocery loading may begin following your onboard checkout) Friday evening.

Saturday, June 16 (9am) through Friday, June 22 (noon) - Sailing in the US San Juan and Canadian Gulf Islands.

Notes:

- The prices listed by the boats include the charter fee for chartering your boat from 9am Saturday, June 16 through noon Friday, June 22, the daily damage waiver and liability coverage fee for your boat, the Friday (June 15) evening barbecue and preboard/sleepaboard, your skippers meeting, onboard systems checkout, ASA-hosted cruising party, flotilla fees/activities, linens & towels, dinghy with 2HP outboard and all applicable taxes. Also included is a 1-year membership to ASA (various benefits include travel, charter and retail discounts, and complementary 1-year subscriptions to Sailing Magazine and the ASA Journal). The flotilla price does NOT include provisioning, meals ashore, dock/moorage fees, or fuel.
- Your vessel's fuel tank will be full at the start of your charter and must be returned full. Please top off at the fuel dock in Bellingham. A \$100 fuel top-off fee, plus the price of fuel, will apply if your vessel is not returned with a full tank.
- 20% of your all-inclusive price will be due at the time of booking, as a reservation deposit. After that the remainder of your balance will be due 60 days before your flotilla starts. Unless you have made other arrangements we will automatically charge the remainder of your balance to your credit card at that time.
- Please designate a skipper for your boat. The skipper will need to submit his/her sailing résumé to us for approval.
- Cancellation Policy: If you must cancel your charter 120 days or more prior to its start, your reservation deposit will be returned less a \$100 processing fee. If you need to cancel within 120 days of your charter, all fees paid will be refunded if we're able to rebook the charter, less a \$100 processing fee. Please carefully consider cancellation insurance. We suggest Travelguard (www.travelguard.com).

Provisioning:

There's a full-service grocery store (Haggen Food, 6AM - 11PM, 360-671-3300) including deli, meat counter and bakery, 5 minutes by car from SJS's docks (or a \$10 taxi ride). In addition, provisioning is also available in the San Juan Islands at both Friday Harbor and Roche Harbor, as well as in the Gulf Islands.

Transportation Tips (directions on our website):

1. Option A - Fly to Bellingham airport (BLI) via Delta, Horizon, or Allegiant Air. Both Delta and Horizon offer connections from other major airlines. Then taxi (approx. \$15) from airport to San Juan Sailing.
2. Option B - Fly to SEA/TAC airport in Seattle (SEA), rent a car (both Hertz and Avis have a one-day, one-way, no-drop-off-charge) and drive (100 miles) to San Juan Sailing. Return the car to the Bellingham Airport before your charter starts and take a taxi back to SJS (approx. \$15). Advantage: You'll have a car for easy provisioning.
